



CAG Travel Bursary Application 2017

The Catholic Archivist Group (CAG) Travel Bursary Program is designed to provide funding assistance to CAG members in good standing for travel to the annual CAG general meeting and conference. Bursaries will be awarded for 50% of total travel costs to a maximum of \$500.00 per applicant up to a maximum of \$5,000 in budgeted funds for that year are expended. Approval and the amount of assistance granted will be adjudicated by the CAG Grants and Bursaries Adjudication Committee. This bursary cannot be used to cover baggage costs, insurance or other ancillary costs.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must be a member in good standing, or work in an institution which is a member in good standing of CAG.
2. Applicants must apply in writing to the CAG Grants and Bursaries Adjudication Committee by posted deadline. Late applications will not be reviewed.
3. Applicants should stipulate the amount of funding that they are requesting. In the instance of institution support for a portion of expenses the maximum may not be required and may therefore be expended toward other applications.
4. The Travel Bursary Program is reserved for applications from the general membership with the exclusion of members of the Grants & Bursaries Adjudicating Committee.
5. Preference will be given to first time applicants.
